- To provide cultural briefings to ACATs and Aged Care Service Providers in order to create an awareness of the specific needs of the elderly seniors from CaLD background and also to bring to their attention the issues affecting the CaLD ageing population within the target communities, which prevent them from accessing aged care service.
- To establish networks and linkages between the CaLD Community and Age Care Providers.

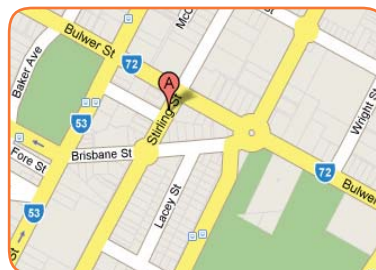

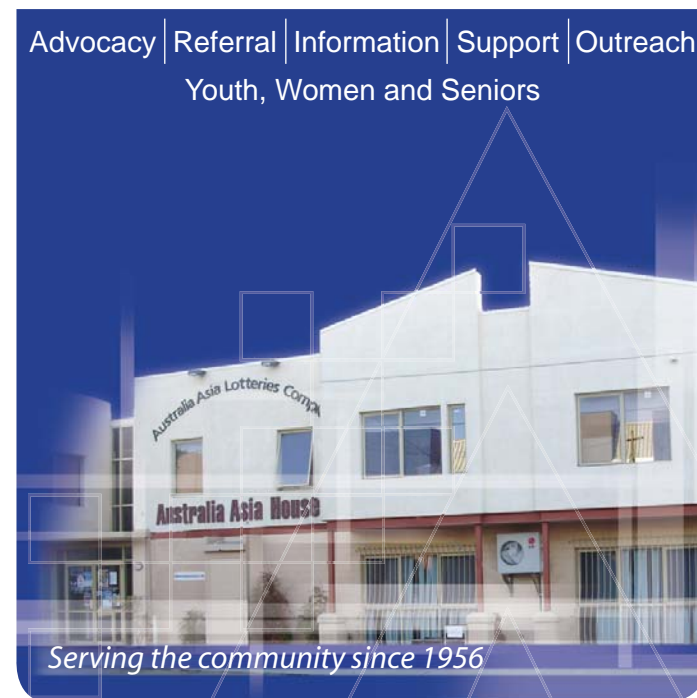
