Funded by the Australian Government through the Department of Health and Ageing

Under this program, the CPP coordinator seeks to:

- 1 Provide information on the availability of aged care services and application procedures to members of the following communities: **BANGLADESHI, BURMESE, FILIPINO, INDIAN, PAKISTANI, SPANISH** and **SRI LANKAN**. The information given to members of the target communities will help them make better informed decisions on the appropriate aged care services to meet their needs.
- 2 Develop a working relationship with government committees and other related agencies which deal with aged care services in order to disseminate information and also promote access to aged care services among members of the target CaLD communities.
- 3 Provide cultural briefings to residential aged care providers especially the Occupational Therapy section so that they may better support their clients from these CaLD communities. Discuss relevant issues that may help them cater more culturally and linguistically appropriate aged care services.
- 4 To develop and strengthen the networks and linkages between the CaLD Communities and Aged Care providers.
